Route:

START: Romsey Bus Station

Leave the Bus Station by the EXIT and turn R.

R at mini Rbt

2nd exit at Rbt in Romsey Square (Palmerston's Statue)

SO at mini Rbt just before railway bridge on to A3057

L on B3084 at The Duke's Head PH to AWBRIDGE

L on minor road sp *Kents Oak/Awbridge* 3.3 miles

L sp *Carters Clay/Newtown* 4.7 miles

Continue up over hill to junction with A27

R through SHERFIELD ENGLISH

2nd L to PLAITFORD and junction with A36 sp *Wellow Wood Chapel/Plaitford* 7.4 miles

R on to A36 then L into New Road 9.8 miles **EXTRA CARE REQUIRED VERY BUSY ROAD**

SO at X to NOMANSLAND

Continue up Piper's Wait

R at X onto B3078

R on to B3080 at Bramshaw Telegraph 14.3 miles

Continue on B3080 through WOODFALLS and REDLYNCH to DOWNTON

R after TL on minor road to ALDERBURY *No sign post Barford Lane* 19 miles

R opposite gate to Longford Castle *No sign post Tunnel Hill* 23.6 miles

Continue up hill taking 1st L

SO at X to EAST GRIMSTEAD

L at T sp *Farley Winterslow* 27 miles

1st R as you leave village to WINTERSLOW

R at sp *Middle Winterslow* 30.6 miles

Follow road through village, up hill, bear right then turn L sp *West Tytherley* 32.7 miles

L into The Warren SP *The Wallops* 33.5 miles

Continue up hill then descend to T with A30 Turn R (**EXTRA CARE**)

2nd R on to B3084 to BROUGHTON 36.7 miles

R on minor road sp *Lockerley, East & West Tytherley* 39.1 miles

L at T to EAST TYTHERLEY, LOCKERLEY, and AWBRIDGE sp *Lockerley*

R at T on to B3084

Continue to T at The Dukes Head PH A3057

R to FINISH at The World of Water, Romsey. 47.7 miles
